Step 2: Request

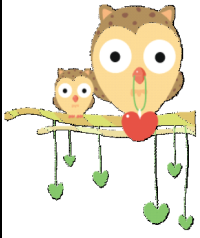
Once you've found your items, give the "Request" button a click and you're on your way. After putting in your library account information, the owning library will drop it in a bag and send it your way.
