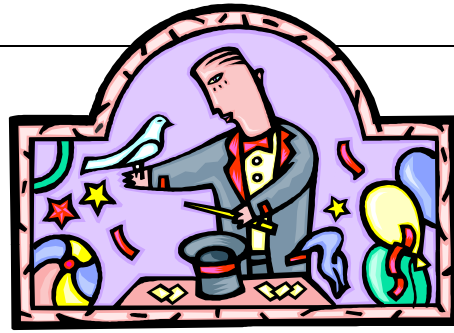

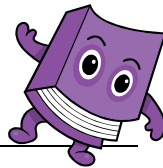


Spring Break Magic Show

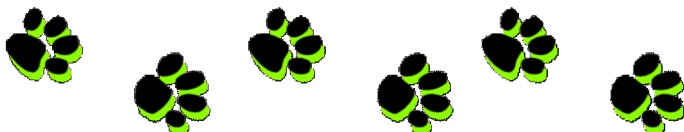
Join Miss Lucinda from the Christian County Library for storytime at the Ozark Community Center.
